**A scholarship for first year students studying toward a career in engineering**

**Application Deadline: December 1<sup>st</sup> , 2017**

**Scholarship Background and Requirement:**

Tulsa SWE scholarship awards 1 to 2 Certificate of Merit recipient each year who meets the below requirement with a value of **\$500**. This scholarship provides financial support to students who want to pursue a major in engineering.

In order to be qualified for the scholarship, student must meet all the requirements below:

- 1) A recipient of Certificate of Merit 2016
- 2) Highly involve in STEM or extra curriculum activities
- 3) Plan on going to an ABET Credited Engineering School in Fall 2018.
- 4) Will join SWE Collegiate section when starting college. The scholarship will add \$20 to cover the membership fee for the first year.
- 5) Write an Essay with a minimum of 300 words and a maximum of 500 words answering **both** of the topic questions below:
  - a. Explain why you want to study engineering
  - b. Explain why you are the best candidate for this scholarship

If you are selected as a winner of this scholarship, you will be congratulated via email and mail with instruction how to receive your scholarship by **April 1, 2018**.




**Step 1:** Access Tulsa SWE website via address: <http://tulsaneo.swe.org/>

## Tulsa NEO Certificates of Merit and Scholarship Program

The Certificate of Merit (COM) is an achievement award presented to female students completing their junior year of high school. The recipients are chosen by the faculty of the math and science departments and administration of their schools on the basis of their achievements in math and science, their character, and their desire for a future career in engineering, math or science. The award consists of a certificate that can be recorded on college and scholarship applications as well as a copy of the book *Is There an Engineer Inside You?* **Nomination form will be available online in 2018**

In addition to COM, the Tulsa NEO SWE will select 1-2 COM recipients per year to award \$500 scholarship through an application. The goal of this scholarship is to provide financial support to qualified candidates who want to major engineering. To be qualified for the scholarship, candidates must meet **ALL** of the below requirements:

- A recipient of Certificate of Merit from the previous year
- Highly involved in STEM or extra curriculum activities
- Plan on going to an ABET Credited Engineering School
- Join SWE Collegiate section when starting college - the scholarship will include an additional \$20 to cover the membership fee for the first year
- Write an Essay with a minimum of 300 words and a maximum of 500 words answering both of the topic questions below:
  1. Explain why you want to study engineering
  2. Explain why you are the best candidate for this scholarship

May 1, 2017: Deadline to submit COM nomination  
May 12, 2017: Announce COM recipients with package by mail and email. Online scholarship application form is OPEN  
December 1, 2017: Deadline to submit online scholarship application  
April 1, 2018: Announce scholarship recipient by mail and email  
July 1, 2018: Check is sent to scholarship recipient


